Session aim/objective/description

Following the success of the 2025 Network Day for Autism RP, we are pleased to build the offer of networking opportunities and professional development by introducing a day of training and collaboration for SEMH designated RP.

The day aims to provide time to explore how trauma, attachment and communication needs are large contributing factors to SEMH challenges, alongside providing strategies to strengthen practice and skills within settings.

Sessions	
Morning	Hampshire Virtual School will be offering a comprehensive training session on the impact of trauma and attachment experiences on learning and development with strategies to strengthen relational practice in settings.
Afternoon	The Specialist Teacher Advisory Service for Communication and Interaction will spotlight the links between speech, language and communication needs and SEMH. They will be exploring strategies which can be employed by all staff in settings.

Learning outcomes:

By the end of the training session, participants will be able to:

1. Explain the impact of trauma and attachment experiences on children's learning and development and recognize how these factors influence behaviour and engagement in educational settings.
2. Apply strategies to strengthen relational practice within their setting, fostering positive connections that support emotional regulation and resilience.

3. Describe the links between speech, language, and communication needs (SLCN) and SEMH challenges, understanding how these areas interact.
4. Implement practical strategies to support SLCN and SEMH needs that can be employed by all staff to create inclusive and supportive learning environments.


