SEN Advisers



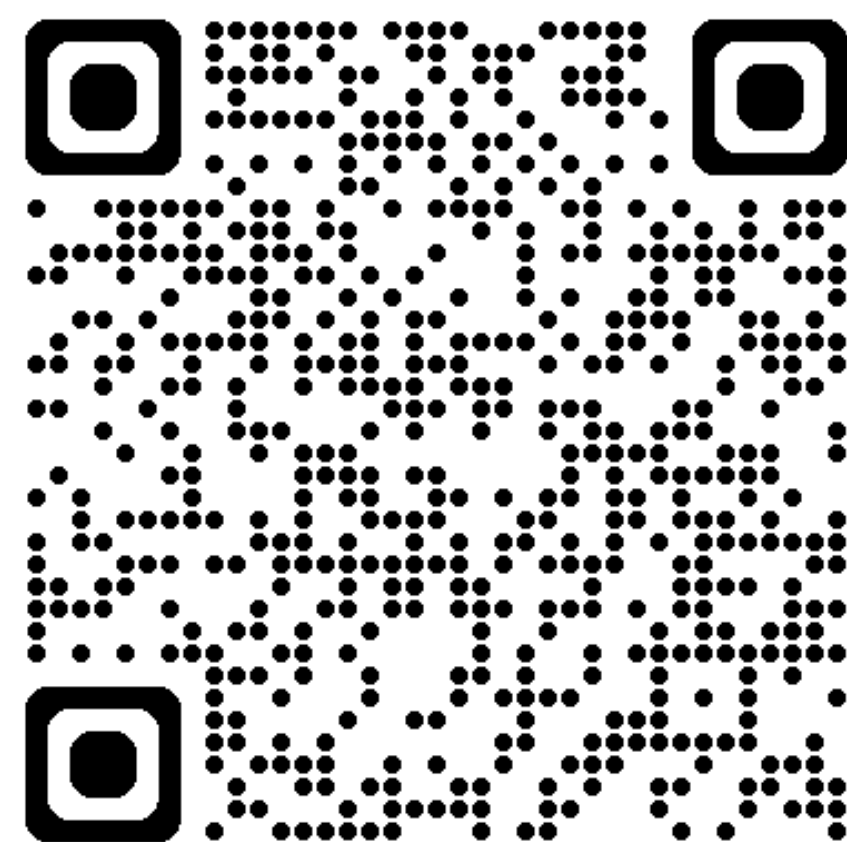
Three **SEN Advisers**, who operate our SEN Support phone line and manage our SEN Support Toolkit.

Virtual meeting to update on key issues pertinent to the SENDCo in schools, including updates both nationally and on a county level, and information from Local Authority officers.

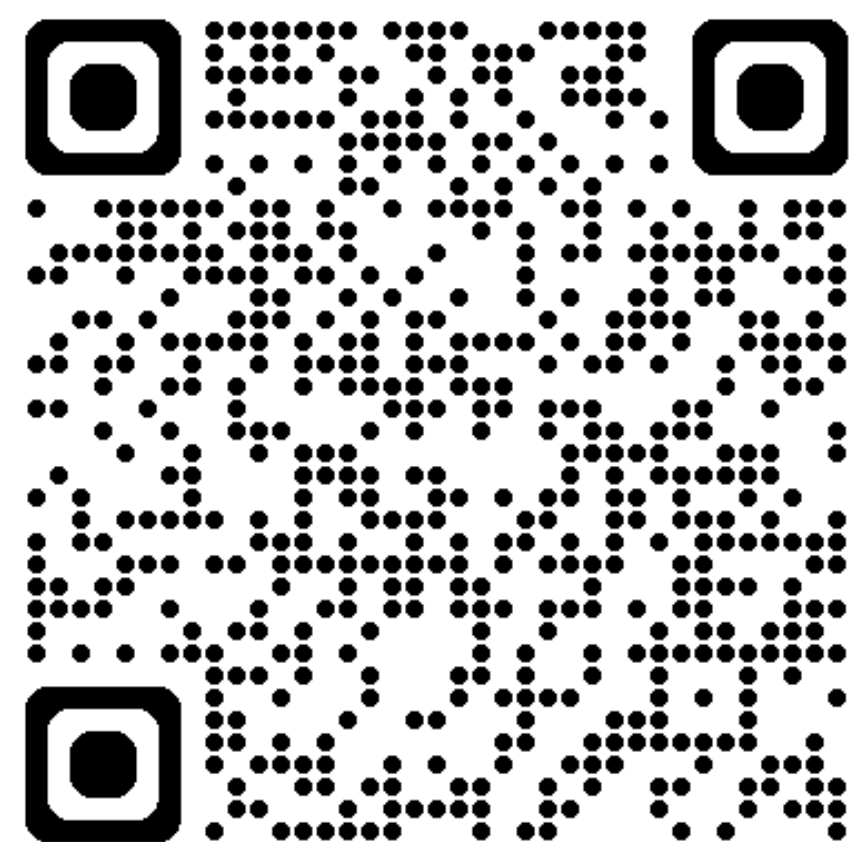

Tackling Educational Disadvantage Networks (Primary)



Supporting primary leaders in developing meaningful, research-informed strategies to tackle educational disadvantage and to securely embed these strategies into day-to-day practice.
