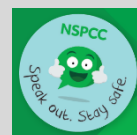
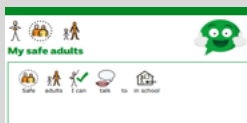


NSPCC resources to support d/Deaf children and PD



Speak out Stay safe is our flagship safeguarding programme for pupils working at a KS1 or KS2 level. There are BSL versions of both of the pre-recorded virtual assemblies - one for children aged 5-7 and one for children aged 7-11.

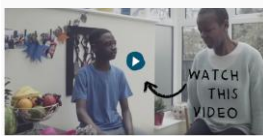

Our video contains British Sign Language (BSL) messages, the deaf body language to them and they should not be afraid if they're upset or worried.

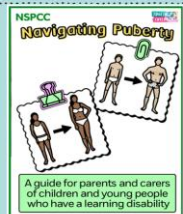
