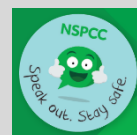


NSPCC resources to support children with MLD/SLD



Speak out Stay safe is our flagship safeguarding programme for pupils working at a KS1 or KS2 level. There are BSL versions of both of the pre-recorded virtual assemblies - one for children aged 5-7 and one for children aged 7-11.

We have recently launched some **Additional Needs Lessons** with **Widgit** and **Differentiated tools**. These resources support children to understand and process the safeguarding messages at their own pace. To find out more or sign up for the resources visit: nspcc.org.uk/speakout.



SOSS SEND/ASN/ALN is a multisensory, flexible safeguarding programme for Specialist Schools and resourced provision to support pupils who have a range of additional needs. It involves six, circle time sessions, that build on learning and are aimed at pupils working at upper KS2 level or above. However this programme can be adapted for pupils with SLD.

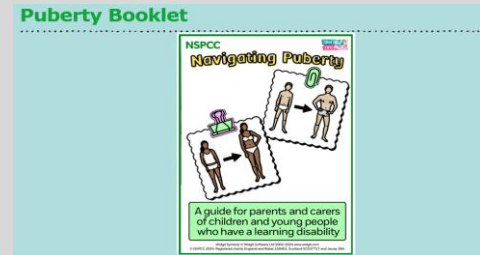

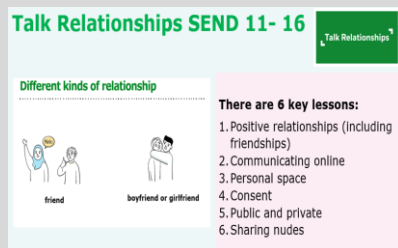
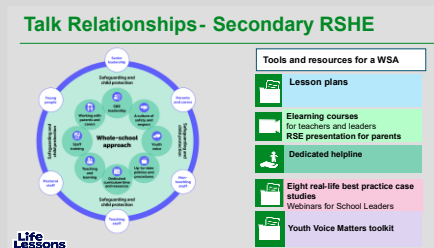
